
















Introduction of MPA




Program Structure





Step for Registration Master Project Paper (SPA 592) - Part-Time Mode of Study

- 1. Prepare a proposal and find a potential supervisor semester 3 (Year 1)
 - 2. Register for project paper (spa592) semester 1 (Year 2)
 - 3. Submission project paper (spa592) semester 2 (Year 2)


