MSW is a programme that combines social work knowledge and field practice (practicum).



It is designed to train social work practitioners from government and non-governmental organizations.



MSW is a mixed mode programme which integrates coursework, practicum and research.



For the full-time option, the minimum duration is for three semesters (18 months) and a maximum of 6 semesters (36 months).






Evaluation System


Candidates will be evaluated according to Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) System with the following grade scale distribution:
